The teacher has an understanding of early childhood development and will engage students in learning through a wide variety of instructional approaches. The teacher will work collaboratively with the other Kindergarten teachers and be in support of a professional learning community focused on the success of each student. Furthermore, the teacher will work in partnership with parents, maintaining an open line of communication regarding student achievement and learning.
