Position Description: Extended Care Aide

Reports to: Principal and Extended Care Program Director

Extended Care Program Mission:

St. Cecilia School Extended Care Program is a nurturing, caring, and friendly environment that provides a high quality before-and after-school program for students in K4 through 8th grade. Our main goal is to offer the children a safe, fun, and comfortable environment. Our focus will be on providing each child with new challenges that will result in a rewarding after school experience.

Terms of Employment:

- The Extended Care Program operates on school days from 7:00 am – 7:30 am (8:30 am on Wed) and 2:30 pm – 6:00 pm (M-F), and on minimum days from 12:00 noon – 6:00 pm.
- The Extended Care Aide position will be scheduled from 2:30 pm – 6:00 pm but may also be requested to be available for other possible shifts during the hours needed such as on minimum days.
- The Extended Care Aide position is part-time and hourly. Rate of pay based on prior experience and education.

Job Goal:

The Extended Care Aide will assist the Extended Care Program Director and other staff members with the implementation of a quality program that enriches the students spiritually, academically, socially, emotionally, and physically. Daily expectations include:

- Ensuring the safety of the students in all situations within the Extended Care Program.
- Leading children in outdoor and indoor activities
- Assisting students in completing their homework assignments and day-to-day needs
- Preparing, serving snacks as well as maintaining a clean and organized environment
- Maintaining a professional and appropriate attitude and appearance towards students, parents and other staff members.
- Performing all other duties associated with the position, as requested by the Principal and Extended Care Director.

Job Qualifications:

- Education: High school diploma or equivalent preferred, with the intent to focus on child development, or related field. Senior year students in good standing in high school will be considered.
- Work/Professional Experience: Previous experience in After School program environment helpful, but not required. Childcare experience helpful, but not required.

Requirements:

- Must be able to communicate with children, parents, and other staff members in a professional, ethical and responsible behavior.
- Demonstrate leadership and positive authority with children.
- Must be congenial and have a desire and ability to work with children and other staff members.
- Promote a safe and healthy environment to support the emotional and social development of the children
- Demonstrate initiative, ability to create and develop fun after school ideas, and work well with a minimum of supervision
- Minimize absences and idle time at work. Demonstrates punctuality and conformity to working practices.
