POSITION DESCRIPTION

- 5 ½ month full-time exempt with benefits
- Reports to the Assistant Principal and Principal
- Responsible for planning, implementing, and assessing all components of 6th grade Religion, and English Language Arts curriculum for both classes in 6th Grade. This includes literature, writing, and grammar
- Attend overnight Outdoor Education Trip – 4 days, 3 nights
- Serve as a member of our school teaching team, whose mission it is to educate and form the whole child in virtue and intellect
- Lead/support ancillary 6th grade activities/programs and perform supervisory duties
- Performs additional duties at the request of the Principal
