- Maintain an open and cooperative relationship with students, colleagues, and parents.
- Contribute to the life of the School and Parish outside the classroom.
- Participate in faculty and departmental meetings and perform various faculty supervisory duties or additional duties as needed.
- Assist students in adapting and overcoming problems that emerge due to learning difficulties
- Provide resources and instructional strategies that give students the physical, social, emotional, and intellectual support needed to learn
- Create a positive learning environment for all students which includes assisting with ILP's
