Basketball Academy Coach

St. Anne School, an independent Catholic School in Laguna Niguel, is seeking a positive, enthusiastic Basketball Academy Coach for our 3rd—4th grade program. The Basketball Academy is designed to introduce students to the sport in a fun, supportive environment—no prior experience required. The ideal candidate will enjoy working with young children and have a passion for teaching the fundamentals of basketball.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Acts as a role model of professionalism in a Catholic environment.
- Supports the philosophy, policies, and goals of the school, as well as the decisions made by the Board of Directors and Administrators.
- Ensures the health, safety, and welfare of all students.
- Maintains strict confidentiality on all school-related matters.
- Follows all school policies and procedures as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook and Employee Handbook.

POSITION OVERVIEW:

The Basketball Academy Coach will be responsible for introducing basic basketball skills—such as dribbling, passing, and shooting—in a positive, age-appropriate way. The program is designed to help young student-athletes explore the sport, build confidence, and decide if they'd like to pursue it further in future seasons.

This is a non-competitive program. There are no formal games, tournaments, or competitions. Coaches may lead basic drills, skill stations, and informal scrimmages to build interest and understanding of the sport.

SEASON:

• Begins in August and ends with playoffs in mid to late October.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- Typically meets 1–2 times per week.
- Sessions take place after school, between 2:30 pm and 4:30 pm.
- No practices or sessions during school breaks or holidays.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Reliable and able to commit to the full session schedule.
- 2. Experience playing or coaching basketball, especially with younger children.
- 3. A positive attitude and a love for working with children who are new to sports.
- 4. Must pass a background check.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS & WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Environment:

Work is performed indoors in the school gymnasium.

Physical:

Vision:

Normal vision range with or without correction.

Hearing:

Normal hearing range with or without correction.

This is a part-time, non-exempt position. Pay begins at \$40 per hour.
